# Fit enclosure to your bathroom



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


# Methods for shower enclosure assembly

When buying a shower enclosure it is worth remembering that there are different ways to install it, obtaining different aesthetic effects. The shower enclosure can be mounted on the shower tray or directly on the floor - with glass line or edge of the profile along the border of the tiles.




## 1 Installation on the shower tray – the external dimension of the shower tray (A1 and A2 dimensions)



Shower enclosure producers give the dimensions of the shower enclosure as a shower tray dimensions, on which it will be set. In fact, the external dimensions of the cabin are smaller, because the exterior edge of the cubicle's profile is spaced from the edge of the shower tray.

## 2 Installation without a shower tray – the external dimension of the shower enclosure on the edge of the tile/fugue (dimensions X1 and X2)




Dimensions X1 and X2 are the external dimensions of the cabin (counting from the wall to the outer contour of the profile or buckle). If you want the outer edge of the cubicle's profile to be mounted on the edge of the tile/fugue, please read the dimensions X1 and X2 from the tables placed near the technical drawing of each model in further part of the catalogue.

**3** Installation without a shower tray – glass line on the edge of the tile/fugue (dimensions Y1 and Y2)



If you want the glass lines to be installed on the connection of the tiles (ran along fugue) without the necessity of ordering a custom shower enclosure, please read the dimensions Y1 and Y2 from the tables placed near the technical drawing of each model in further part of the catalogue.



To ensure an easy access to the shower area, we can install a shower enclosure or a shower door without the threshold strip.




Shower enclosure without the threshold strip

# Coatings on glass

Everybody knows, how important hygiene in the bathroom is and how difficult and time-consuming it is to keep a bathroom clean. This applies in particular to big glass surfaces.

## EasyClean®

The **EasyClean®** coating is a protective polymer layer – invisible with the naked eye – deposited on the surface during glass processing. It has water-repellent properties, which is why water drops are not maintained on glass surface, but they run down without leaving precipitates. As the protected glass surface does not enter into direct contact with water, it does not undergo corrosion, while precipitation of any impurities and development of bacteria on such surface proceed at the rates and in quantities that are many times lower than in the case of glass without such a coating.

In the process of depositing the coating, the **EasyClean®** layer unites permanently with silicon contained in glass and becomes a part of glass surface. The coating created in this manner is durable and this makes it different from glass impregnates available on the market, as the latter provide only short-term protection. Unfortunately, under the impact of water and cleaning agents, the effective protection provided by the coating (especially its water-repellent characteristics) gradually decreases. Therefore, it is recommended to apply the **EasyClean® Glass Protector** on to glass surfaces every 6 months, in order to recondition the protective layer.



# Partition wall



## Challenge

Elegant, but with a hint of raw materials – this is how the client has imagined her future bathroom. Arrangement of bathroom with limited space in the aesthetic and convenient way can be very challenging. Different types of partition walls allow to divide the space into separate functional zones, as well as to improve its proportions.

## Solution




Even in a small bathroom, it is possible to divide the space into several utility zones – in this case a decorative partition wall marks the boundary between the basin and shower zone. In first, we have arranged a quick washing zone with a mirror and sink. Beneath the long table top there is a lot of space, eg. for a washing machine and a basket for dirty laundry. In the shower area we have installed custom shower enclosure from Almatea KDJ series, which gives a sense of separate space. A sheet of tempered glass mounted on the low wall does not overwhelm the bathroom as whole wall.

# Attic bathroom #1



## Challenge

The bathroom is considered the most difficult interior in the attic to arrange. Troublesome slants hinder greatly its arrangement, but it does not mean you cannot design a functional bathroom there.

## Solution




The bathroom in the attic has an unique atmosphere. To make it easy to arrange and functional, you need to appropriately reallocate space beneath the slants. Focusing on comfort and usability, designers and investors decided to mount a large and comfortable Euphoria Walk-in shower enclosure. Cabin was made to order and the wall was cut to fit a slant.

# Attic bathroom #2 – niche



## Challenge

Unusual shape of the room and the sloped roof hindering movements – these features of the bathroom in the attic were very challenging for the interior designers. Slants and horizontal beams supporting the roof add an unique character to the interior, but also take the usable area and hence reduce the space.

## Solution




To gain more space and functionality in the bathroom in the attic, you can use the niches and slants. If they are large enough, the best solution is to install the shower enclosure. In the presented case, we decided to mount the custom niche door – Eos DWS, that open both to the outside and inside. Shower door fitted to the sloped roof allows an optimal use of a small bathroom, which is too tight for a full size cabin.

# Attic bathroom #3



## Challenge

Bathroom seemingly large, in fact – due to the bevels – small and difficult to arrange. The placement of the toilet, sink, shower enclosure and bathtub so that you can use them freely is not an easy task – but it is not impossible.

## Solution


A custom-made shower enclosure is a great solution for use on a bathtub, especially in small-sized bathrooms, in which these two elements must come into contact with each other. The use of a non-standard Art KDJ I shower enclosure with a side wall mounted on the wall solves the problem of uncomfortable, hard-to-reach space between the bath and the shower, which is very hard to clean. In addition, we obtain a useful shelf inside the bathing zone. Thanks to this, cosmetics are always at hand and you can reach them at any time.

# Attic bathroom #4



## Challenge

Elegant, but with a romantic note – this is how the client imagined her future bathroom in the attic. Bathrooms designed in adapted rooms (former attic or loft) have one huge advantage. In general, they are larger than those “standard” built at home. The biggest challenge that such an interior confronts us is the practical use of roof slants and combination of functionality with aesthetics.



## Solution

Arranging the bathroom in the attic requires thoughtful planning. It must be remembered that the room's surface is not the same as the space to be arranged. In order to fully adapt the area near the knee wall, it is worth using it as a place for storing e.g. cleaning products or a laundry basket. Created in that way the partition wall may become the part of the shower enclosure. Investors decided on the Euphoria KDJ cabin, in which the glass door were cut so that it fits perfectly under the slant. To gain additional centimeters, we reduced the level of the shower using the solution based on a shower board with a drain line. The elimination of the shower tray, in addition to its practical advantages, also provides interesting visual effects.



## SITUATION 6

# Bathroom with bathtub and shower #1



### Challenge

Investors are the married couple, who wanted a bathroom adapted to their individual needs (she loves long baths, while he prefers quick showers). Bathtub or shower enclosure? This is a common dilemma when designing the bathroom, especially if the interior is cramped and not easy to arrange.

### Solution



The bathroom does not have to be large to meet the needs of the fans of bathtubs and shower enclosures. To fit both devices in this space is not a problem when using a custom Fuenta KDJ cabin with one wall mounted on the bathtub. As a result, we gained functional and ergonomic room. This type of development is practiced both in smaller bathrooms, as well as more spacious.



## SITUATION 7

# Bathroom with bathtub and shower #2



## Challenge

The investor wanted to rearrange his old bathroom. He wanted to install both spacious shower enclosure and a comfortable bathtub. He asked us for help in laying out of these elements. The main challenge in this bathroom was in fact the waste pipe located only on one wall.

## Solution




To meet the requirements of the investor, we decided to install Premium Plus shower enclosure with double doors allowing a comfortable entry. The location of the sidewall on the bathtub allowed to create a single, clearly marked bathing zone. Because of the depth of the shower enclosure it was necessary to cut out the rectangle in the sidewall.

## SITUATION 8

# Bathroom with bathtub and shower #3



### Challenge

The client asked us for help in choosing a shower enclosure for the bathroom in which a wall-mounted bathtub was already installed. She wanted to be able to take advantage of both a quick shower and a relaxing bath. The problem was, however, the small size of the room. In practice, it turns out that not only individual preferences are important when making decisions – the bathroom size is also an important criterion.

### Solution


To meet the requirements of the client, we proposed a custom Arta PND bathtub screen with an additional side wall. It's a compromise that allows us to relax in the way that suits us the best at the moment. Thanks to the additional side wall, the water does not escape outside the bathtub, making the area around the toilet and bathroom rug dry while using the shower.

# Small niche



## Challenge


Presented bathroom is located in a newly built block. It is a main bathroom for a family of 2 + 1. The apartment is not large, so the bathroom, in addition to its primary purpose, functions also as a small laundry and utility room.

## Solution



The small bathroom requires optimum use of space and its arrangement must be carefully thought out. Take advantage of any, even the smallest existing niche. Depending on the size and the place where they are located, they can perform different functions, but remember that you can install a shower enclosure even in a small niche. An interesting way is to use the custom cabin with a profile mounted to the front or side of the wall. In this case, we have offered Torrenta KDJ shower enclosure, which frameless door gives the impression of delicacy and clarity. Frameless shower enclosures with transparent glass add smoothness and lightness to the interior space, and thus increase it optically.






Mounting the profile to the side of the wall

# Column



## Challenge

The biggest challenge in the presented bathroom was a column, which gave the investors sleepless nights. However, we managed to convince the customer that it does not have to be unsightly architectural element.

## Solution




The charm of the bathroom can be brought out not only by impressive furniture, decoration and light, but also with the participation of the architectural details eg. exposed wood or steel columns and structural beams. Those standing in the middle of the room can play different roles – towel rails, a place to hang the sink or toilet bowl. While those located closer to the walls can be used as one of the elements of the interior. The column above was surrounded by Eos II DWJ shower door and Carena sidewall, what gives it additional practical sense. Structural column has become an integral part of the shower enclosure, which presents amazingly in the bathroom.

# Bathroom ceramics too close to bath area #1



## Challenge

The client asked us for help in the selection of the shower enclosure for the bathroom, where the toilet was located close to the bathing zone. When planning the bathroom, we are often dependent on the fixed elements e.g. the location of the plumbing, which often forces the localisation of individual equipment.

## Solution


The main challenge presented by the investor was to place all the elements of the bathroom without any changes, in the same places, which they were on the construction plan. To be able to freely open the shower enclosure's door, we had to produce Eos II KDS shower enclosure in custom dimensions. Its doors open both to the inside and outside, without interfering with the hanging toilet bowl.

# Bathroom ceramics too close to bath area #2



## Challenge

In this bathroom project, heavily constrained in setting, the basic problem was too little space between the washbasin and the bath area. When planning the location of your bathroom equipment, you should plan the amount of space needed to ensure your comfort.


## Solution

It turns out that a small bathroom does not have to be uncomfortable. With properly selected elements of the interior you will be able to carry out your daily chores collision-free, gaining also a place to relax. Non-standard Carena DWJ shower door fits into the interior perfectly. Right door, opening to the inside, do not interfere with hanging sink located next to the bathing zone. This solution allows smooth operation. Rail handle also allows hanging a towel on the outside, so that it is always at hand.

# Bathroom ceramics too close to bath area #3



## Challenge

The presented bathroom put a considerable challenge in front of the authors of the project. In the small space they had to fit several sanitary facilities that we use every day, such as toilet seat, sink, radiator or cabinet and washing machine. The key issue when designing the interior is to ensure the convenience of its use, and the appropriate arrangement of these pieces of equipment is a problem for almost every owner of a small bathroom.

## Solution




The client asked us for help in choosing a shower enclosure in the bathroom, where the toilet and sink are located very close to the bathing zone. The challenge was to put the cabin so that the bathroom ceramics would not hinder the access. Arranging the interior of the room, we proposed a custom model of the shower enclosure based on two products: Eos KDD B and Eos II KDD. On the one side, the door opens both inside and outside, without interfering with the toilet next to it. On the other side, thanks to the door that folds on the wall, we get a wide and comfortable entrance to the bathing area. Even in a small bathroom, we can create a functional shower.

# Sliding shower enclosure mounted to the ceiling



## Challenge

Ceiling showers are an increasingly popular solution. The client installed one in his bathroom and asked us about the possibility of creating a shower enclosure mounted directly to the ceiling, which will have a sliding door and will be devoid of a stabilizer profile.

## Solution


The customer's expectations can be met by the Furo shower enclosure with sliding doors without a track and mounted on rollers at the bottom. We increased the height of the fixed walls and mounted them directly to the ceiling. The role of the stabilizer in this solution is played by the front wall. The glass has an undercut in order to place a handle stabilizing the door operation. Thanks to this, we met all the wishes of the client, the transparency of the design was maintained, and the model remained elegant and optically light. This solution can be used in both wall-mounted and corner shower enclosures.

# Seat in the shower enclosure



## Challenge

Investors (elderly married couple) have turned to us for help in the selection of the shower enclosure to a renovated bathroom. Their only requirement was to place the seat in the cabin.

## Solution




We have proposed a model based on Euphoria DWJ+S series, which appeals to all enthusiasts of showers. In order to increase comfort, we decided to broaden the comfortable and functional seat so that it stepped outside the cabin space. Additional area can be used as a place to put aside the towel or personal belongings.

# Uneven walls



## Challenge

The walls and ceilings in the apartment may seem even and smooth, and the angles between them right. Meanwhile, during its arrangement, it often turns out that the reality is different. In the bathroom, the problem usually occurs when laying tiles or installing a shower enclosure.



## Solution




If the shower enclosure is installed on uneven wall surface, we do not have to renovate the entire bathroom immediately. We have two options. The use of profiles that have an appropriate range of adjustment and leveling the curvature of the wall, or cutting the glass to size into a trapezoidal shape. Thanks to the second solution, we can install the shower enclosure with subtle brackets (as in the Arta DWS shower door), which are suitable for mounting only on straight walls. In this way we obtain the effect of a light cabin without a large amount of chromed elements.

# Spacious bathroom



## Challenge

What distinguishes the spacious bathroom from the standard one is the open and large space. In addition to the bathing and toilet area, there is also a relaxation zone with a comfortable armchair or chaise longue or dressing table with scented candles. It is worth ensuring that the spacious bathroom is not only stylish and atmospheric, but also functional.



## Solution


With such a large surface, we can apply a wall-adjacent and comfortable shower enclosure, which will be not only functional, but also highlight the style of the room. That is why designers and investors have decided on Espera cabin with sliding doors. Thanks to many options offered by Radaway, we can adjust the shower enclosure to any interior. We can, for example, order it in non-standard dimensions or select a glass variant. We have several options to choose from – clear glass, brown, graphite, satin, Pixarena, Mirror or UltraClear (characterized by exceptional brightness and crystal transparency), as well as ShowerGuard glass with lifelong protection against limescale deposits.

# High partition wall



## Challenge

The design of each bathroom should take into account the needs of every household member, intimacy during the use of all sanitary facilities and functionality that will result from the specific character of the room. For this purpose, it is best to create useable areas of the room, which will be separated by means of various walls or partitions.




## Solution

Partition walls in the bathroom are a good way to organise the space and divide the interior into zones. In order to increase the usability and ergonomics of the small and narrow bathroom of our clients, we proposed to put a partition wall. In this case, it sets the boundary between the shower and the toilet, providing privacy to the family members. The decorative wall also makes it easier to keep the bathroom clean (due to the close proximity of the toilet and the cabin, the glass pane would be exposed to dirt). The use of the non-standard Arta DWD shower door and cutting them to the partition wall made it possible to adapt to the new interior layout. In addition, a tempered glass pane mounted on the wall does not overwhelm the room like a full wall.

# Enclosure of concealed frame



## Challenge

The concealed frames have revolutionised the issue of hiding pipes in bathrooms, increased the ergonomics of the room and additionally became an interesting decoration, which also serves as a practical shelf. The frame casing can go beyond the necessary fragment and connect with other elements of the bathroom. The investor wanted to extend the shelf and create a place for storing cosmetics or utensils needed in the shower.

## Solution




Radaway shower enclosures allow to create a comfortable and functional shower zone, tailored to the expectations of various clients. The use of the Idea KDJ non-standard cabin with the appropriate cut-out made it possible to adapt to the interior layout and to create an additional space for toiletry products. Thanks to this, cosmetics are always at hand and you can reach them at any time.

# Bathroom for older person



## Challenge

Presented bathroom is to serve an older person, who decided (for safety reasons) to replace the bathtub with comfortable shower enclosure. In old age, even simple things are starting to be difficult, thus the arrangement of the bathroom for seniors can be a challenge.

## Solution



The basic requirement not only in the bathroom, but in the whole apartment of an elderly person, is to maintain one level of the floor. For this reason, we chose shower board, allowing free access to the shower area. Extensive doors of non-standard Eos + S II DWD shower enclosure open both to the inside and outside providing a comfortable entrance and maximum safety. The natural choice was a variant of the cabin without the threshold strip, which allows free use without overcoming any height barrier.



## SITUATION 21

# Bathroom for a disabled person



## Challenge

Investors – a family whose member is a person in a wheelchair – asked us for help in designing a shower enclosure adapted to the needs of a disabled person. A bathroom is a room which every user, also a person with mobility problems, should use it freely.

## Solution


A bathroom adapted to the needs of people with reduced mobility must meet high requirements in terms of functionality and comfort. The Eos non-standard shower enclosure with bifold door provides a wide and comfortable entrance to the cabin. The use of the shower board allows maintaining one level of floor in the whole bathroom and enables free entry while using a wheelchair. The seat, in turn, is a functional addition that will facilitate safe and convenient use of the shower. It is also a comfortable element for other family members. Body or foot peeling, depilation of legs or other care treatments are much easier when sitting down.

# Keeping intimacy in the bathroom



## Challenge

The bathroom is a place where we should feel comfortable and freely. This is why it is extremely important to ensure a sense of intimacy. The arrangement of functional space (particularly small in size), taking into account the needs of all household members, can be quite a challenge.

## Solution




A functional bathroom is a place which the household members use with pleasure and feel comfortable in it. When planning this type of room, it is worth dividing it into usable areas, for example by means of various walls or partitions. This allows you to organize the space and actually separate it, for example, to isolate the toilet from the bathing part, allowing the use of several people at the same time. The additional partition wall created also a niche ideal for the shower enclosure. However, due to the proximity of the sink to the shower area, we proposed a custom Eos KDJ cabin, which door was cut and the profile was mounted to the front of the wall. This allowed the optimal use of space in the presented bathroom.

# Shower enclosure close to the window



## Challenge

In the presented bathroom, the basic problem was a small area of the room, many bends of the walls, as well as a window, which on the one hand is an asset, and on the other limits the arrangement possibilities. When designing such an interior you need to focus on the smallest details.

## Solution




Standard bathroom equipment includes several elements, which usually are located on a small area. Problems, however, begin when a little room has a window, and in addition a lot of bends in the walls. In the case of the presented bathroom designers and investors decided to place the standard Modò New II shower enclosure in the niche located at the end of the room. In the case of such location of the shower enclosure, it is not possible to use a standard support bar mounted to the wall. The solution to this situation is the installation of a non-standard telescopic support bar. It is a minimalistic solution for stabilizing the glass, strengthening the structure of the cabin without the need for long perpendicular stabilizer.

# Small bathroom



## Challenge

Arranging a small bathroom is a challenge. It is worth rethinking every centimeter of the surface, so that you can then use it comfortably. Applying a few simple methods can significantly affect both the visual and functional side of the interior. However, how to combine the need for practical solutions with the need for originality? The answer may be a shower enclosure, in which ... you can see yourself.


## Solution

The small size of the bathroom is one of the most troublesome aspect when arranging a room. It is worth considering the bathroom design, setting and selection of sanitary equipment and devices, as well as the location of the mirrors. Achieving a stylish effect is possible due to the right selection of key pieces of equipment. Therefore, for the bathing part, we proposed a non-standard Arta KDS I shower enclosure with a side wall mounted on the wall, which made it possible to adapt to the interior. The use of mirror glass allowed the optimal use of the bathroom surface, while providing the highest functionality in a modern edition. In addition to the undeniable utility value of this solution, it increases the bathroom arrangement options. The mirror surface optically enlarges the space and enhances interesting decorative elements planned in the bathroom.

# Shower doors mounted at an angle



## Challenge

The presented interior is located in a block of flats, where the sewage plumbing is located on one of the walls of the room. Housing created in this way and a small bathroom surface create problems for investors.

## Solution




Bathroom space is usually determined by factors independent of us. The slants, housings of equipment and technical elements limit the arrangement possibilities. Due to the unusual shape and small area of the room and the close proximity to the toilet, we proposed a custom Eos KDJ shower enclosure. Its walls are placed at an obtuse angle to each other, thus not taking a valuable place in the bathroom. The wide entrance additionally increases the comfort of use. Thanks to the possibility of making a shower board in non-standard dimensions, the cabin could be mounted directly on the floor. The solution visually enlarged the room and added a few valuable square meters of the surface.

# High transparency



## Challenge

The presented bathroom is located in a beautifully situated cottage near the forest. The owners' dream was to create a bright, spacious room. That is why they have decided on white colour and glazing occupying almost the entire wall. Clients, having a view of the surrounding nature, also used it to decorate the interior. Investors asked us for help in choosing a shower enclosure that would fit into the interior and match the view outside the window.

## Solution


In this case, the choice fell on Essenza KDJ shower enclosure with UltraClear glass. Many people think that the glass itself is a fully transparent material, but the reality is different. Conventional glass, through the use of iron compounds during its production, is characterized by a greenish shade. In many cases, this colour does not have a significant impact on the aesthetics of the surroundings, but when it is different, it is worth reaching for UltraClear glass – characterised by a low content of iron oxides. As a result, a very transparent, almost invisible material is obtained, which ideally suits to interiors maintained in bright colours. It works well wherever glass edges are visible or when a neutral colour is desired. As a result, the view of the forest offered by the bathroom window is completely undamaged.

# Room doors




## Challenge

In many modern apartments, it is becoming more and more fashionable to combine the bedroom and bathroom space. However, how to separate this space while maintaining the advantages resulting from the optical combination of rooms?

## Solution




In this situation, we suggested replacing the standard door with a shower door made of tempered glass. To increase the aesthetic value and give both rooms a unique character, we chose the Factory glass variant for the Nes Black DWD II door. Thanks to the effect obtained, the client receives an optically separated border of private zones and at the same time maintains the impression of spaciousness of the rooms.




## Challenge

The glass pane defining the space can be used not only in the bathroom. Radaway designers faced the challenge of using tempered glass as a partition wall in a modern, bright apartment with high ceilings.

## Solution


Glass is a durable and effective material that can also be used as a building element in accommodation spaces. The proposed solution is a shower enclosure mounted to the ceiling using dedicated profiles. Thanks to the use of a glass pane as a partition wall, we have gained an aesthetic division of the space, while illuminating the rest of it. On the Modò XL Black walk-in cabin, we additionally placed the Letters engraving, which harmoniously harmonizes with the modern interior.

# Storage for the washing machine



## Challenge

In modern apartments, it is rarely possible to afford the luxury of having a separate room as a laundry. In most of our homes, the bathroom is just such a place. So how to fit in a washing machine and clothes dryer to maintain aesthetic value and combine it with functionality?

## Solution



During the renovation, our client decided to replace the shower enclosure and install a washing machine and clothes dryer. As a solution, we proposed the Eos DWJ I shower door and profiles and glass from Eos series as a housing for both devices. Thanks to this, when taking a shower, light reaches the interior of the bathing area, and household appliances are tastefully hidden.

# Colourful print on glass



Print Radaway is the brand's service that allows you to make an original print on the glass of the shower enclosures, shower doors and bathtub screens.

Modern technology, for which a specialised digital printer is used, allows you to apply a thermosetting ceramic paint on the glass. The applied pattern is combined with glass during the toughening process, which guarantees extraordinary durability – the motif will not wear off and will remain intense despite the passage of years. The print is made on the outside of the cabin, which makes it easier to keep it clean (the protective EasyClean coating is located on the inside of the shower enclosure).

Print Radaway is available in several glass variants: transparent, UltraClear®, brown and graphite glass.

## Technical requirements:

High resolution (the longer side of the photo should be 4000 px), the fewer elements in the photo, the better the final effect, the object that is the target of the effect should be clear (clearly distinguishable from the background).
